I **APPENDIX A. RECOGNITION OF SWISS CERTIFICATES AS EQUIVALENT TO A SWISS "MATURITÉ GYMNASIALE"**

The following Swiss diplomas are recognised by the Management as being equivalent to a Swiss Maturity certificate in accordance with the RRM or ORM, or a cantonal Maturity certificate recognised by Switzerland in accordance with the RRM or ORM

- Bachelor's degree, Master's degree, licence, diploma, doctorate from a Swiss university within the meaning of the Federal Law on the Promotion and Coordination of Higher Education in Switzerland. This does not include continuing education diplomas (MAS, DAS, CAS, EMBA, postgraduate diplomas, etc.);
- Graduation diploma from a study programme lasting at least three years at a Swiss University of Applied Sciences or a Swiss University of Teacher Education within the meaning of the Federal Law on the Promotion and Coordination of Higher Education in Switzerland. This does not include continuing education diplomas (MAS, DAS, CAS, EMBA, postgraduate diplomas, etc.);
- A degree from a Swiss university of applied sciences acquired retrospectively, provided that the competent body has validated the conversion of the degree (only for degrees awarded before 01.01.2009);
- Federal vocational matriculation certificate or specialised matriculation certificate recognised at Swiss level combined with successful completion of the complementary ("passerelle") examination of the Swiss Maturity Commission;
- Cantonal Maturity certificates that are not recognised by the federal government:
 1. General literary baccalaureate in the canton of Neuchâtel;
 2. Artistic Maturity from the canton of Geneva;
 3. Musische Maturität in the canton of Basel-Landschaft;
 4. Maturity (Maturité type F) in visual arts in the canton of Jura;
 5. Lehramtmaturität in the cantons of Zurich, Aargau, Glarus and Schaffhausen;
 6. Abschlusszeugnis der Maturitätskurse für Berufstätige in the canton of Basel-Stadt;
 7. Cantonal commercial high school diploma;
 8. Cantonal secondary school-leaving certificate in education;
 9. Other cantonal school-leaving certificate not mentioned in this appendix, provided it was obtained before 2004 and corresponds to a general education course. A Gymnasial Baccalaureate is considered to be general

education if at least six independent subjects from the following list have been taken during the last three years of education (upper secondary):

- i. First language (mother tongue)
- ii. Second language S
- iii. Mathematics
- iv. Natural sciences (biology, chemistry or physics)
- v. Humanities and social sciences (geography, history or economics/law)
- vi. Option (a subject from fields ii, iv or v or computer science or philosophy)

- Cantonal primary teaching certificate or diploma acquired on completion of five years' training;

- Secondary school teacher certificate or District school teacher certificate, insofar as it has been obtained on completion of a secondary school teacher training course at a Swiss university.
